

## Market Place considerations - based on questionnaire research, discussion and realities on the ground

Access needs to be maintained to Cross Hill House and adjoining property

Design to take account of existing siting of bus shelter and phone box.

Parking is an unknown so designs need to vary to take account of these options:

- No parking in the market place
- Fewer parking spaces
- The same level of parking

Design to include:

- The siting and protection of 2-3 trees
- Improved but reduced amount of paving
- Appropriate lighting / access to electrical supply
- The siting of 2-3 benches / tree seats
- The siting of a memorial to John Harrison / Longitude theme
- The siting of information board(s) or equivalent
- Improving the context of the Market Cross / Stock Stones

### Notes

*Re flower / shrub beds, an interesting suggestion was made – that planted up wheelbarrows would make an attractive and appropriate display and could be maintained more easily than permanent beds. Anchorage to the ground could be included in the engineering and if damage occurred, a barrow could easily be removed and replaced. Local businesses could sponsor / supply barrows and perhaps contents.*

*Memorial to John Harrison / Longitude theme: this would need to be a separate tender with an estimated amount included in the final bid*
